Construction Changes and Holiday Planning Tips at Dallas Love Field

November 17, 2011 – Dallas Love Field is preparing for the holiday season and wants to remind the public about this year's construction activity. For our local and out-of-town travelers who are flying during the holidays – but are not familiar with our construction program – here is a recap of changes and a list of tips to plan for a smooth trip at Love Field.

Major changes due to the on-going Love Field Modernization Program (LFMP) and reconfiguration of the Airport this year include:

- If you park in Garage A, use the East Pedestrian Bridge on the third level of the garage to access Terminal 2 (Southwest Airlines) or to navigate to Terminal 1 (United-Continental Airlines, Delta Airlines and SeaPort Airlines).
- The Cell Phone Waiting Lot has been relocated, with easy access off Cedar Springs Road. New directional signs have been posted to help you locate the lot. To ease roadway congestion, wait in this area for passengers - there is no charge to temporarily park and wait in the Cell Phone Waiting Lot.
- Expansion of Cedar Springs near Terminals 1 and 2 began earlier this year and will continue through the holiday season. Parking and waiting in front of the Terminals is prohibited.

A few tips while planning your trip to Love Field:

- Arrive at least 90 minutes before your flight to allow enough time for check-in, baggage check, security and any unplanned event. Check with your airline for flight departure/arrival status.
- There are approximately 7,000 parking spots in the Garages A and B, as well as additional parking at private parking companies near the Airport.
- Passenger drop-off at Terminal 1 (United / Continental / Delta / SeaPort) is curbside near the terminal entrance off Cedar Springs.
- Passenger drop-off at Terminal 2 (Southwest Airlines) remains at the lower level entrance off Cedar Springs.
- Carry-on items are limited to one small bag and one personal item (ie: camera, laptop, briefcase and purse).

- Make sure all gifts are unwrapped for both carryon and checked baggage.
- Currently pies and cakes are permitted through security checkpoints, but be aware that Transportation Security Administration (TSA) regulations may change. Sauces, jams, jellies, dips and other liquid food items more than 3.4 ounces must be in checked baggage only.
