All calls will be handled through 311. Night drop kennels at the shelter are available seven days a week from 7:00 a.m. to 11 a.m., adoptions 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
<b>3-1-1 Customer Help Line</b>	Customer Service Representatives will take service-related urgent calls such as water main breaks, downed trees/limbs, signal lights out/down and animal control. Water Customer Service will be closed. <b>Police</b>	Administrative offices closed Department will operate on normal schedule
<b>Dallas Fire Rescue</b>	Administrative offices closed Department will operate on normal schedule
<b>Court and Detention Services</b>	Administrative offices at 106 S. Harwood and 2014 Main will be closed. Mail payments are accepted with postmark dates honored. Attorney and cash bonds for arrested defendants will be processed 24 hours a day, seven days a week (Including holidays) at the Dallas Marshal's Office, 1600 Chestnut St.
