## **Buckner Terrace Homeowner's Association to hold grand re-opening and ribbon cutting for Samuell Boulevard reconstruction**

**What:** The Buckner Terrace Homeowner's Association (HOA) will celebrate the recently completed reconstruction of Samuell Boulevard, IH-30 to the city limits. The 2.4 mile construction project transverses Council districts 7 and 4 began in April of 2007 and completed February 2010.

The \$20.9M project, paid for with local, state and federal funds includes reconstruction of a two-lane asphalt roadway with bar ditches to a four-lane divided concrete with underground storm drainage, sidewalks, street lighting, water and wastewater improvements, landscaping and irrigation.
