City of Dallas Sanitation Services offer free storm debris collection

Dallas residents can call 311 or take debris to transfer stations or landfill

The City of Dallas will provide free storm collection debris for Dallas residents who were affected by thunderstorms and winds that hit North Texas on Wednesday night/Thursday morning. Residents who need to clear their property must place cut and stacked tree limbs at the curb and call 311 to request collection. Citations for “out of cycle” brush waste will not be issued if citizens call 311 for collection. Only tree limbs and fencing lost during the storm can be accepted.

Dallas residents may also take storm debris to City transfer stations and the landfill from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. from April 10 through May 10, but must show proof of residency with a driver’s license or current water bill. This special service is being provided in addition to normal sanitation operations. Please call 311 for any additional information.
