**City of Dallas Trinity River Corridor Project
2nd Annual “Carpe Diem” Fishing Tournament
on the Trinity River!**

When: Friday, November 3, 2006
8:15 a.m. (first boats depart at 9 a.m.)

Where: 1000 Hunter Ferrell Road
Irving, TX 75060
Mountain Creek Preserve (Mapsco-41BK)

What: A fishing tournament on the Trinity River!
Spearheaded by Dallas businessman Mike Wyatt, the City of Dallas Trinity River Corridor Project and the Trinity Commons Foundation, boats will be launched from Mountain Creek Preserve in Irving; participants will fish down a six mile stretch of the West Fork, and past the confluence of the Elm Fork, ending at the Trammell Crow Park boat ramp, 3700 Sylvan Avenue. (Mapsco 44-G).

Bragging rights and Texas-sized fish tales will take place at the Trammel Crow Park boat ramp immediately after the tournament, at approximately 1 p.m. Awards will be given for several categories, including largest fish caught and the largest variety of fish caught.

Why: To focus attention on the Trinity River as one of Dallas’ forgotten recreational assets while promoting the Trinity River Corridor Project. Many native fish live in our portion of the river and last year’s winner caught a 10 pound catfish!
