**Garbage and Recycling Collection Delayed for Some
East Dallas Neighborhoods**

A natural gas leak this morning at the City of Dallas Central Service Center fueling station has caused a three-hour delay in the collection of recycling and garbage materials for some East Dallas residents with Monday collection.

Dallas Sanitation Services assistant director for collections, Ron Smith, says customers in the **Gastonwood/Coronado Hills, Forest Hills, Little Forest Hills, Casa Linda Forest**, and some areas of **Casa Linda Estates** neighborhoods will be impacted. "Residents are accustomed to a pretty regular pick-up window; but, because of the gas leak, our trucks couldn't get out on time this morning. We want the public to know we're on the streets now and will be picking up all the garbage and recycling that we're supposed to today."

The natural gas leak is being investigated and repaired by Clean Energy, which operates the city's clean natural gas fueling stations.
